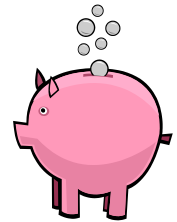


Satanta Grade School Building Report

BANKING

Grade school students will have their first banking day on September 22nd. Stephanie Anton will be starting the program this fall. Bank personnel will be in the building before school for the students in grades 3-6. They will be back in the afternoon for first and second grade students. With the implementation of MTSS reading which includes a 90 minute core reading instruction time for grades K-5 and a thirty minute intervention block for each grade level, scheduling has become trickier and trickier.



HEADCOUNT

As of September 10, the head count for the grade school is 215 from PreK through 6th grade. This is up two from last year. Our largest class is the Kindergarten with 38 students. The PreK has 29 students ages three to four. This enrollment includes four year old students in the At Risk preschool and the three year olds that receive home based support from HPEC>

MTSS

Last week the teachers met with Mrs. Johnson, Mrs. Williams, and I to look at the results of the universal screening and to complete the quadrant instructional sort. Then the students were grouped for the intervention time during Tier Time. The tiered support is starting this week for grades K-6.
