State reading and math assessments have been completed. It will be a little while before AYP reports are released. All juniors will take both the science and social studies assessments while the 7th grade will take science and the 8th grade will take social studies. Their scores will be base line scores and will not be available until the summer.

Spring sports are underway. We hosted a high school track meet on April 1 and a junior high track meet on April 3. Both meets ran off exceptionally well due to the hard work of Miss Lutz and her amazing crew of volunteers. We have another high school meet on April 22 and another junior high meet on April 24. At this point all of our baseball and softball games have been on the road. We will host Syracuse for baseball and softball on April 14.



At the HPL meeting on March 26 Meade was not allowed to join the HPL. The vote was 6-5 in favor, but a 2/3 majority vote is required so they were two yes votes short. The next HPEA meeting will be held in Leoti on May 8. At that time we will vote on Meade for the junior high league unless they withdraw their petition for membership due to not joining the HPL. In the HPEA a simple majority is needed for membership so if the vote goes the same as at the HPL, Meade would have enough yes votes to be allowed membership in the junior high league.
