Immunizations Required for School Entry

- (a) Except as provided in K.S.A. 75-5209(b) and amendments thereto, each child or adolescent shall be required to receive the following vaccinations before enrolling in any Kansas School:
1. Diphtheria
 2. Hepatitis B
 3. Measles (rubeola)
 4. Mumps
 5. Pertussis (whooping cough)
 6. Poliomyelitis
 7. Rubella (German measles; and
 8. Tetanus; and
 9. Varicella (chickenpox), unless proof of prior varicella disease is provided. This proof shall be verified by the following:
 - a. The signed statement of a physician indicating the child's or adolescent's date of this illness;
 - b. The signed statement of a parent indicating the child's or adolescent's date of this illness; or
 - c. Laboratory evidence of varicella immunity.
- (b) The immunization record of each pupil shall document that the pupil has received the vaccinations specified in subsection (a) from a licensed physician or local health department in accordance with the "recommended childhood and adolescent immunization schedule - United States 2003" approved by the advisory committee on immunization practices and hereby adopted by reference.
